- Encourage and support opportunities for people to learn appropriate behaviours and skills.
- Respect the rights and worth of every person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background, personal preferences, and religion.
- Respect the decisions of officials, coaches, and administrators in the conduct of basketball.
- Act with integrity and objectivity and accept responsibility for your decisions and actions.
- Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit.
- Be a good sport. Take the opportunity to applaud all good plays whether your team or the opposition makes them.
- Be consistent and impartial when making decisions.
- Never argue with an official, if you disagree, have your coach or manager, address the matter after the completion of the game in the appropriate manner.
- Focus on effort and performance rather than winning or losing.
- Support opportunities for participation in all aspects of basketball.
- Any physical contact with a person should be appropriate to the situation and necessary for the person's skill development.
